'Back to normal': Next Va. budget faces big bills for Medicaid, education

By MICHAEL MARTZ, Richmond Times-Dispatch (Metered Paywall - 7 articles a month) Virginia is likely to face big bills with less money to pay them in the next two-year budget, as the state emerges from the COVID-19 public health emergency with less federal money available to spend and more pressure on the state tax revenues. As the General Assembly money committees prepare for their annual budget retreats in less than two weeks, they are waiting for estimates on how much K-12 public education will cost to maintain at current levels.

DHCD: Upcoming Input Sessions for the 2024-2025 Annual Action Plan

In order to determine the planning, housing, and community development needs of the Commonwealth, the Virginia Department of Housing and Community Development (DHCD) is undertaking its Annual Action Planning process for the year 2024-2025.

This planning process will result in the development of an Annual Action Plan, which will outline the prioritized needs and best use of resources to address those needs for the upcoming fiscal year. The anticipated federal housing and community development resources include the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), HOME Investment Partnerships Program (HOME), National Housing Trust Fund, Emergency Solution Grant (ESG), and Housing for Persons with AIDS (HOPWA). DHCD will accept input on anticipated federal housing and community resources including goals and objectives for housing and community development, the projected use of funding, and the method of distribution.
